### 2 Glass transport systems

The most recent product of **Officine Mistrello** is the *Bridge Stock Selector*, which travels on rails and is used to pick up PLF glass sheets of up to 6,000 x 3,210mm and DLF glass sheets up to 3,600 x 2,600mm. The Mistrello Bridge Stock Selector can, the Italian company says, transport glass sheets with thicknesses of from 3 to 19mm, and low-E glass



sheets, and can be interfaced with an automatic sorter, as well as being used to unload glass sheets stocked on traditional fixed stands.

Suitable for integration into cutting and laminating lines of medium- to large-sized glassworks, the machines pick up the sheets from the sorters and transfer them automatically to the cutting table. Thanks to shorter pick up and unloading times, the Bridge Stock Selector can feed one or more cutting tables, while ensuring complete safety for operators.

Specific software enables to have interface directly with the offices of the glassworks, ensuring intelligent warehouse and glass management, with continuous rotation of the glass sheets in stock. Moreover, says Officine Mistrello, changeover time from one glass type to another is very short - only two minutes.
